EDC 216 Written Assignment: Theory Papers

You have been invited to make a presentation in EDC 170, Introduction to Counseling. The course is taught with numerous guest lecturers. The professor who teaches the course would like you to speak for 10 minutes on Person-Centered Theory (Gestalt Theory, Behavioral Theory), using the enclosed outline (the course is very tightly structured). In addition, the professor would like a written copy of your remarks, to be used as the basis for later discussion.
